Definitions of Compliance



- No Compliance
 - The standard is unable to support the any portion of the requirement

- Partial Compliance
 - The standard is able to support a portion of the requirement

- Full Compliance
 - The standard is able to support the entire requirement

Boundaries of the Standard Reviewed for Conformance



- Only the normative sections of the standard are reviewable

- Recommended practices and/or specifications are not considered a portion of the normative section of the standard and must not be used for providing full compliance with the requirement. Consortia developed recommended practices may provide guidance for partial compliance.

- The standards available for review are:
 - ISO 10303 - STEP AP242 E1
 - ISO 14306:2012 - JT E1
 - ISO 32000 / 14739 - PDF E1 / PRC E1

Rule for Conformance



- Comments must document how partial compliance is obtained
- Comments must reference the section and page number (if available) of the standard for partial and full compliance
- Requirements that apply to process, tools, archive architecture and function, do not require review and may be marked as “not applicable” in the compliance matrix
